

2004 - 2008 Olympiad Officials' Certification/re-Certification

At the 2005 National Convention the Certification and Re-certification process was streamlined. New officials are required to take the Part I rules review test. All National and Master level officials take the Parts that apply to their level of officiating. National level takes Part II and the Master level officials take Part III. Separate testing for Inspector of Implements - Weights and Measures, Long distance running and X-Country, race walking, or advancing to specialty or upgrade may be requested separately.

Those officials desiring to advance must also meet other requirements of the Association, time in service at the current level, letters of recommendation, and obtain approval by the Association Chair and Officials Committee. Contact the Certification Chair for details on levels and advancement.

Rules Review Instructions:

- . The questions are based on the USA Track & Field 2004 Competition Rules.
- . Read the directions for each testing Part.
- . The Part III test requires three rule books, specifically IAAF, USATF, and NCAA.

General Procedures:

1. Complete 1-11 of the Application including the E-mail address on the Database form and sign in the lower left.
2. Complete the Rules and Review Test Part(s) that apply.
3. Provide an electronic photo for the National I.D. (This must be a digital file to me).

ABSOLUTELY NO CARDS WILL BE PROCESSED WITHOUT A PICTURE.

4. Fill out the Resume Form, for any and all officiating experience in the last two years.
5. Sign the Ethics Agreement
6. Remit 25.00 dollar check made out to NC USATF for registration.
